- like to know a lot about everything


Key Features of GATE program

- work experience opportunities




Key Features of AP Program

- enrichment
- challenging course(s)
- content-based
- accelerated standardized content
- external validation (AP exams)
 - anyone can register to write
- potential for advanced university standing



Key Features of IB Programme

- holistic approach: Global citizen
 - IB Learner Profile character, citizenship, personal development
- course or program
- process & content blend
- accelerated standardized content
- variety of assessments (Int & Ext)
 - TOK, Extended Essay, Creativity, Activity & Service (CAS)
- potential for advanced standing in university
